Maryland, that Section 13-125.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby				
added:

Subdivision 2. Amendments to Housing Code.				
Sec. 13-125.01. Section H-402.1.				
Section H-402.1 is amended to read as follows: "Water Heating Facilities. Every dwelling				
unit shall be supplied with water heating facilities which are installed in an approved manner,				
properly maintained, and properly connected with hot water lines to the fixtures required to be				
supplied with hot water under Section H-402. Water heating facilities shall be capable of heating				
water to such a temperature as to permit an adequate amount of water to be drawn at every

1	connected fixture at a temperature of not less than 120 degrees Fahrenheit at any time needed.				
2	Fixtures equipped with scald prevention valves shall be installed and adjusted to deliver water at				
3	a temperature of not more than 110 degrees Fahrenheit."				
4	SECTION 2 BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)				
5	calendar days after it becomes law.
