REPORT: Favorable 4-0: Council Members Burroughs, Franklin, Ivey, and Turner. Absent Streeter.

The Prince Georges County Council's Government and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on May 12, 2022, to consider CR-049-2022. CR-049-2022 is a resolution amending Salary Schedule "P-O" for Officials in the Prince George's County Police Department, effective July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2022. This legislation is necessary to implement certain modifications to the wages and other benefits of Captains and Majors in the Police Department. This Salary Plan includes the following modifications: wage scale adjustment, retroactive COVID-19 Hazard Pay for the period of September 27, 2020, through April 24, 2021, and notification of transfer provisions.

During the Committee, it was pointed out that this resolution will allow the Officials the same benefits as those covered by the union.

The Office of Law reports CR-049-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Policy Group reports that CR-049-2022 will have a negative impact on the County in the amount of \$1,288,725 for the fiscal year 2022.

After discussion, the Prince Georges County Council's Government and Operations Committee voted CR-049-2022 out favorably, 4-0.
