### PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORTDate: 7/3/96

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-1 (In favor: Estepp, Bailey, Del Giudice and Scott. Opposed: Maloney).

This bill will amend the Section of the County Code which relates to public spas. The amendments were prepared with industry representatives to develop regulations that are less restrictive without compromising public health concerns.

The licensing fees for public spas are removed from the text of the Code and will be recommended by the County Executive and adopted by Resolution.
