RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Contract Approvals

3 For the purpose of approving various multiyear contracts for the Office of Information
 4 Technology.

5 WHEREAS, Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland, requires
 6 that the County Council approve, by Resolution, multiyear contracts exceeding an aggregate of
 7 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00); and

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County,
 9 Maryland no agency of the County Government shall, during any fiscal year, expend any money
 10 or incur any liability in excess of the amounts appropriated and no such payment shall be made,
 11 nor any obligation or liability incurred, except for purchases in an amount to be fixed by
 12 legislative act;

13 WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into contracts with various IT vendors for the continued
 14 use of Microsoft Suite of products, legacy mainframe maintenance, digitization services,
 15 Geographic Information System (GIS) licensing and hosting, desktop and telecommunication
 16 services, and agreements with resellers of commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) software; and

17 WHEREAS, the contracts between Prince George's County, Maryland and the various
 18 identified vendors will be conducted pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein as
 19 Attachments A through M.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
 21 County, Maryland, that the agreement as described in Attachments A through M pursuant to
 22 Section 819 of the Prince George's County Charter be and the same are hereby APPROVED.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make
2 such necessary modifications, adjustments, corrections, or any other changes as may be
3 necessary, to finalize the subject agreements in any manner the County Executive may deem
4 necessary or proper but not altering its substance.
