**BILL**

AN ACT concerning

The Repeal of the Grant Exemption from Procurement Competition

For the purpose of allowing products, goods, services that are funded with a grant to be a part of open competition in the Prince George's County's procurement process.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 10A. PURCHASING.

Section 10A-108

The Prince George's County Code

(2023 Edition).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 10A-108 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

**SUBTITLE 10A. PURCHASING.**

**DIVISION 1. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES.**

**Sec. 10A-108. Exemptions.**

(a) Unless otherwise ordered by the Purchasing Agent, the acquisition of the following supplies and services shall not be subject to Divisions 2, 6, and 7:

[(14) Grants; and]

[(15)] (14) Employment Contracts.

1                    [(16)] (15) Purchases that do not exceed two thousand five hundred dollars  
2                    (\$2500).

3                    [(17)] (16) Services or goods that are to be provided by another government  
4                    agency or government.

5                    [(18)] (17) The Purchasing Agent determines that competitive solicitation  
6                    procedures are not applicable to the requirements or are impracticable for the particular  
7                    supplier and/or services.

8                    SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby  
9                    declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,  
10                   sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of  
11                   competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining  
12                   words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this  
13                   Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such  
14                   invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,  
15                   or section.

16                   SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
17                   calendar days after it becomes law.
