Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 3-0 (In Favor: Council Members Olson, Dernoga, and Fisher)

The Committee convened on October 23, 2025, to discuss CR-127-2025, which approves five (5) locations for stop sign monitoring systems in the Town of Capitol Heights (listed in Attachment 1), based on traffic studies conducted at specified locations:

- Old Central Avenue & Nova Avenue (Northbound)
- Brooke Road & Suffolk Avenue (Southeast on Brooke Rd.)
- Capitol Heights Blvd. & Doppler Street (Northeast on Capitol Hts. Blvd.)
- Capitol Heights Blvd. & Doppler Street (Southwest on Capitol Hts. Blvd.)
- Old Central Avenue and Suffolk Avenue (Eastbound)

Upon approval of these five additional locations, Capitol Heights will have a total of ten (10) approved locations, which include the five (5) original locations approved in CR-106-2024. The August 4, 2025, letter from Joy Ren, Town Administrator (Attachment 1), indicates the Town plans to install seven (7) additional cameras at these five (5) locations.

CR-127-2025 acknowledges that Capitol Heights has met all the requirements for location approval by sending a letter of request to the County Council, conducting traffic studies at specified locations (Attachment 1), and passing a local ordinance (Attachment 4) following a public hearing (Attachment 3). Staff offered a technical amendment to clarify that all requested locations are within school zones. The Committee accepted this technical amendment.

After the discussion, the Committee voted Favorably on CR-127-2025 as amended by a vote of 3-0.
