**REPORT:** Favorable 9-0: Council Members Hawkins, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Streeter, and Turner. Absent: Taveras.

The Prince George's County Council convened in the Committee of the Whole on February 10, 2022, to consider CB-003-2022. As proposed CB-003-2022 will approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between Prince George's County and the Fraternal Order of Police, Prince George's Lodge 89, Inc.

While many of the conditions remain the same, a settlement sheet is attached which lists the terms and conditions of the Agreement. During the meeting, Shawn Stokes, Director, Office of Human Resources Management, provided the Committee a list of the major changes included in the Agreement. It was pointed out that the Agreement includes a wage scale modification in addition to merits and Covid-19 retroactive pay. The agreement also provides for the establishment of labor committees.

The Office of Law finds CB-003-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Policy Group reports that the enactment of CB-003-2022 will have a negative impact on the County in the amount of \$15,837,190.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CB-003-2022 out favorably, 9-0.
