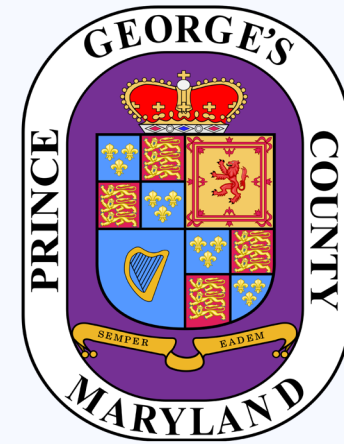

# UPDATE ON TENANT LEGAL PROTECTIONS

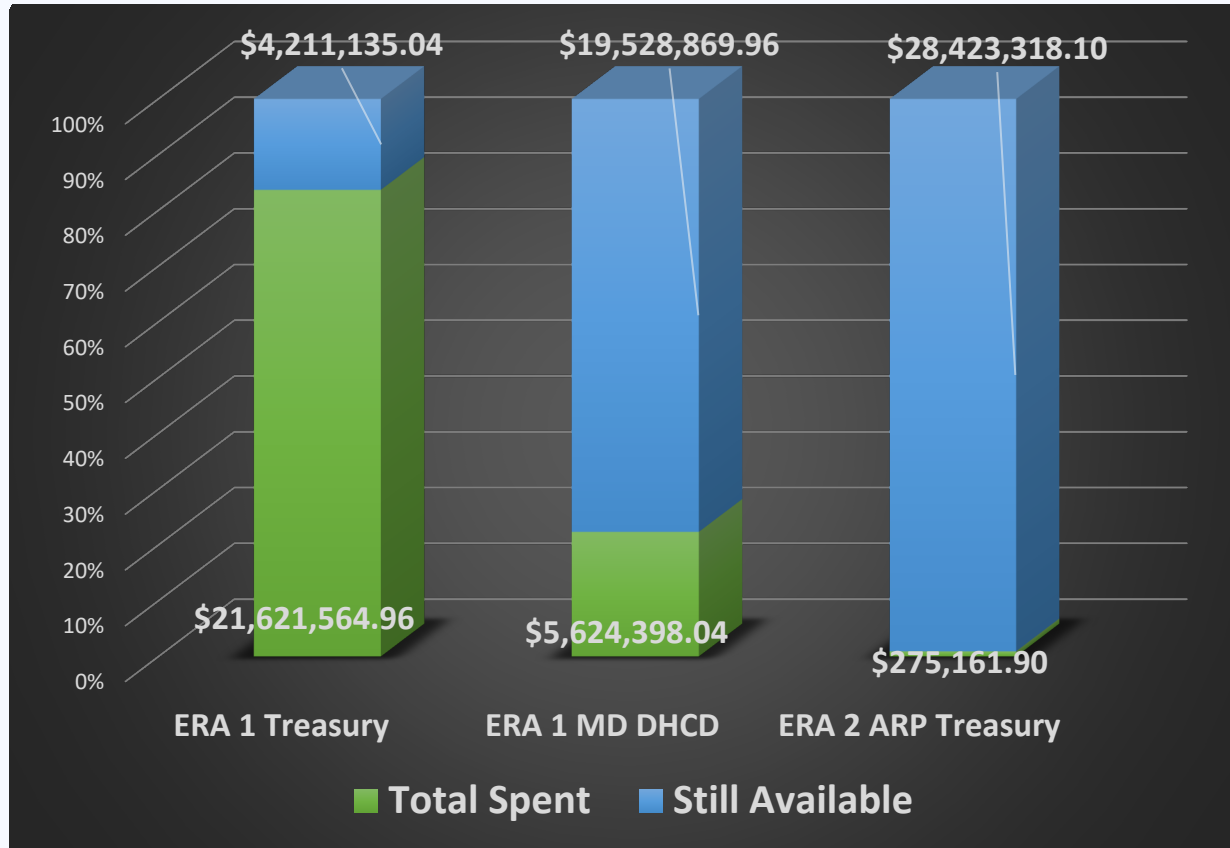
Supreme Court August 26th ruling invalidated the federal eviction moratorium

Governor's eviction moratorium expired August 15<sup>th</sup>

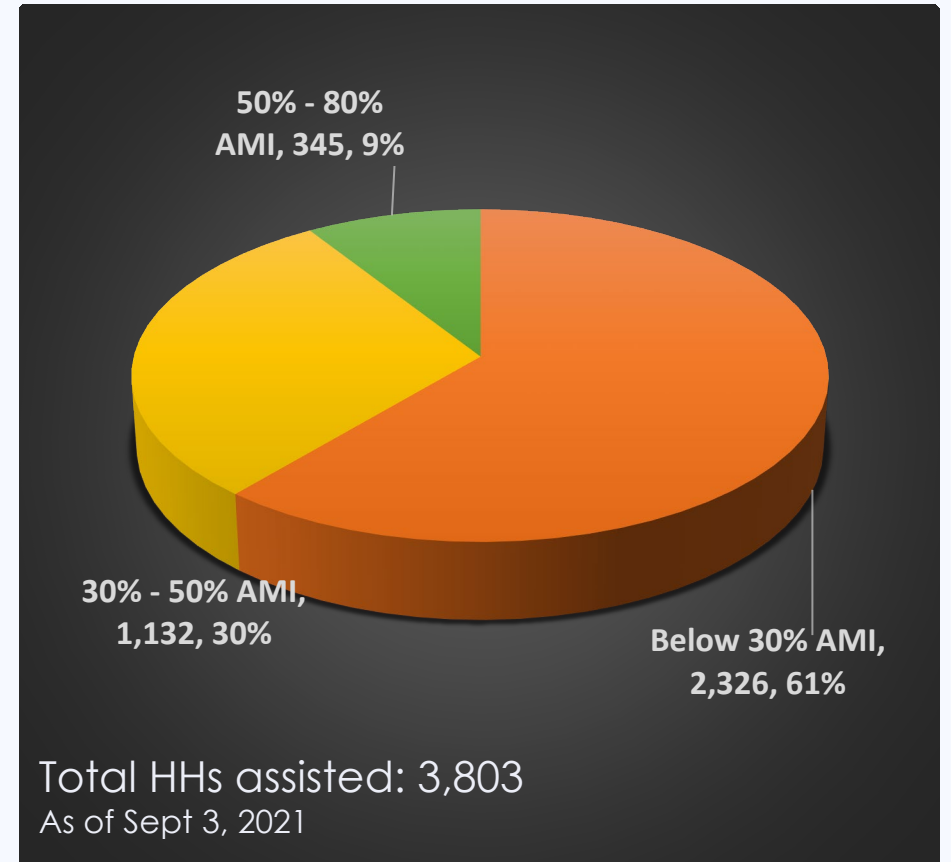
CLS of Prince George's County continues to advocate in the Courts for stays to give tenants time to complete ERAP applications

Ongoing collaboration with the Office of the Sheriff

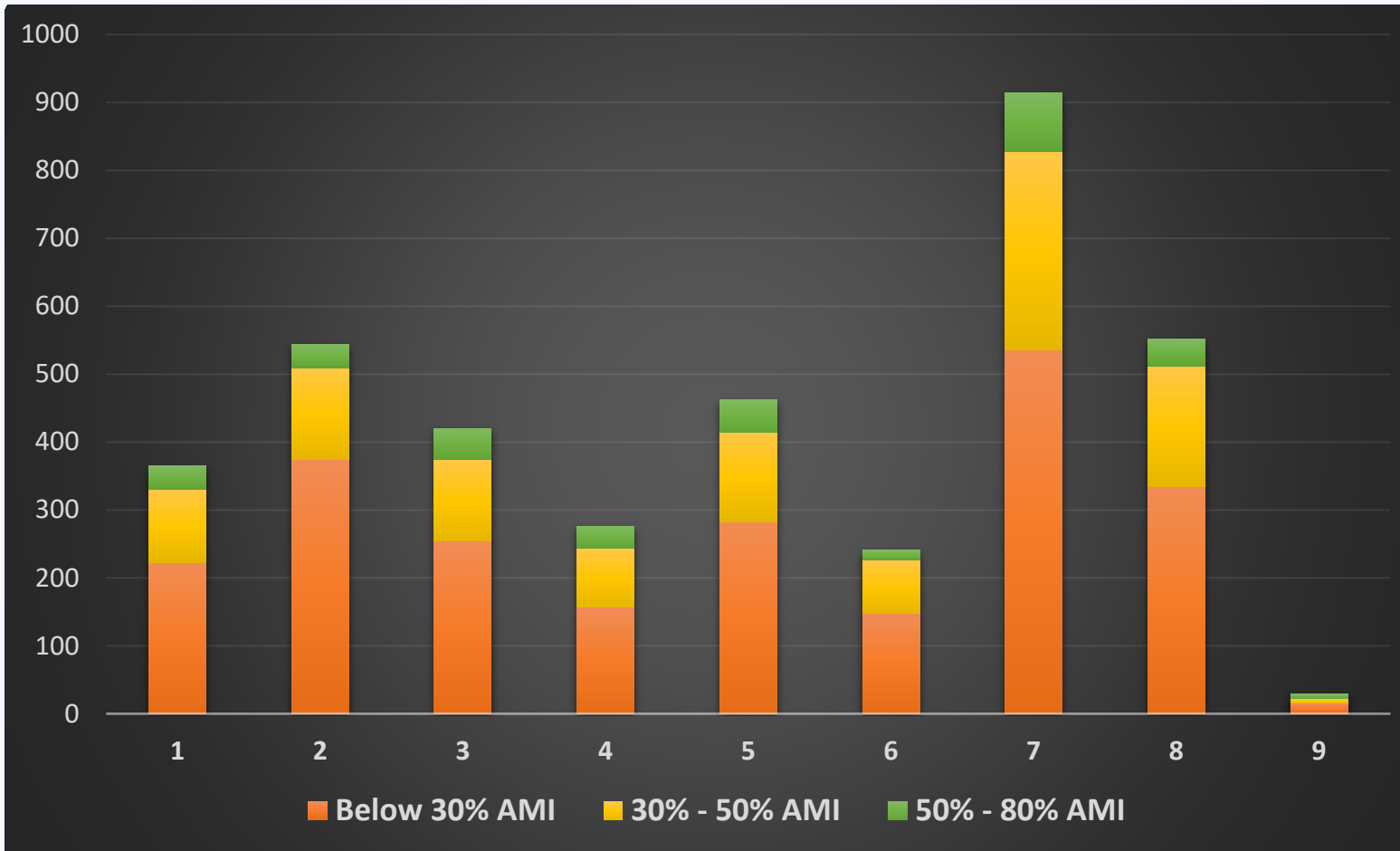

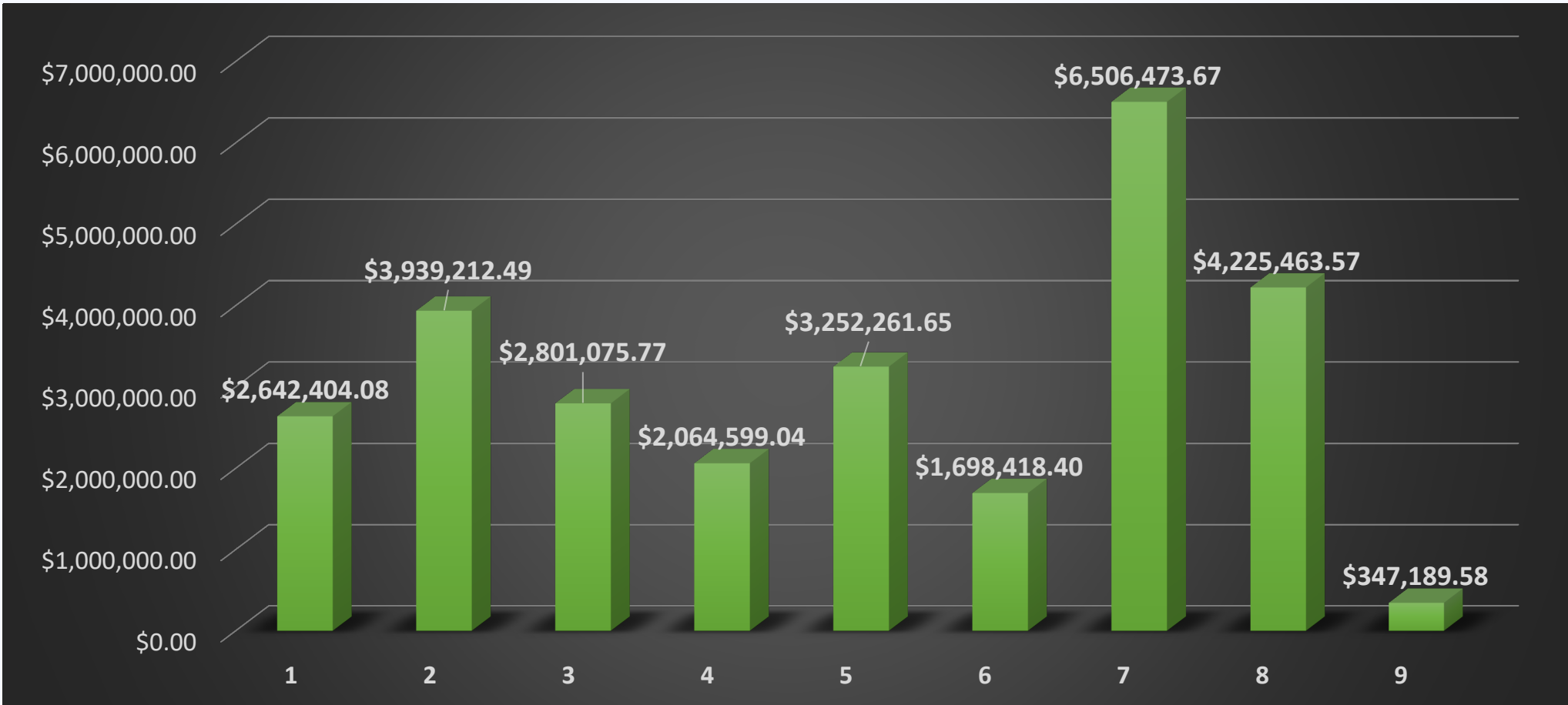


# HOUSEHOLDS ASSISTED PER DISTRICT — AS OF SEPTEMBER 3, 2021

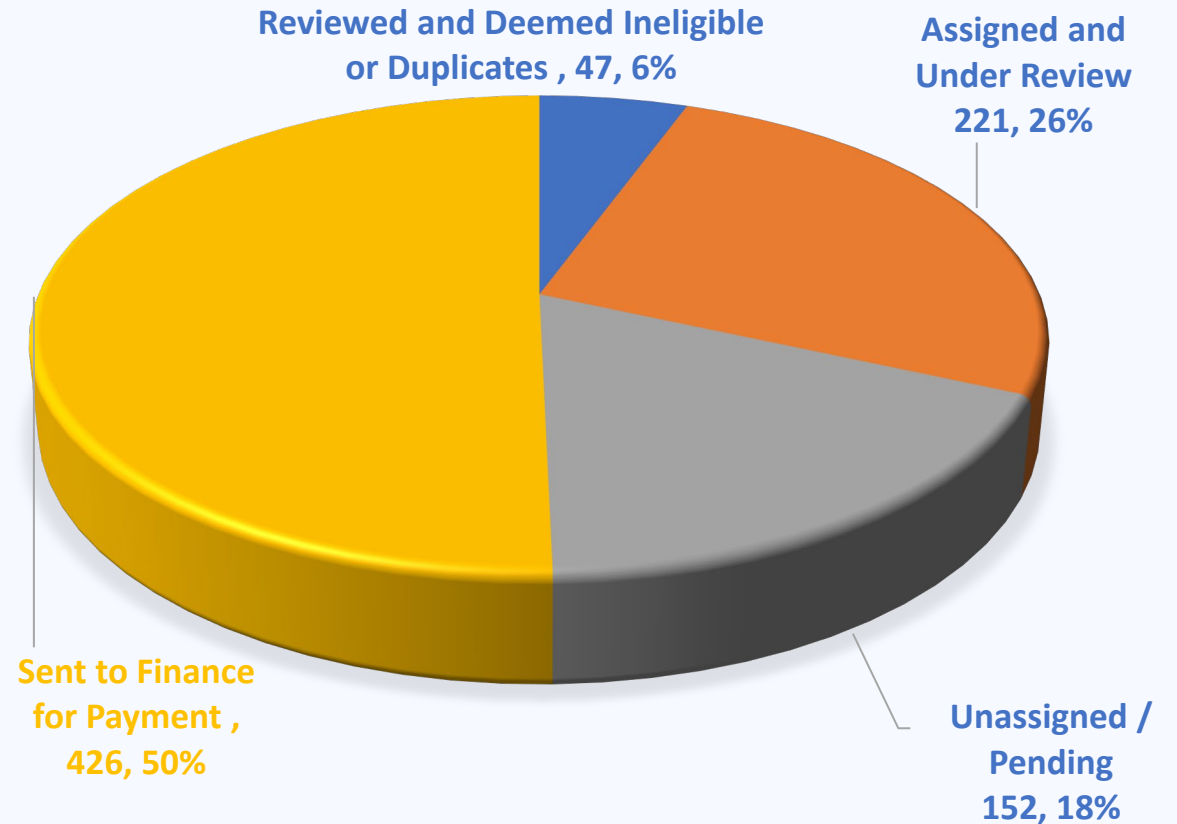

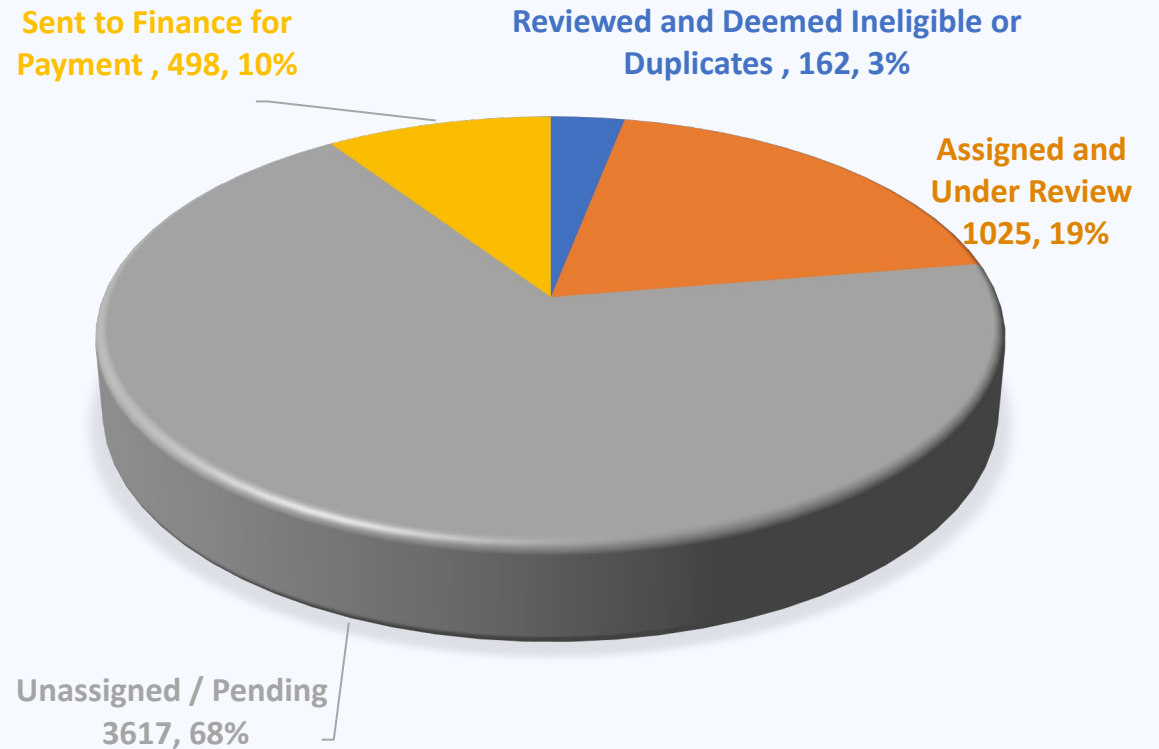
