Article 23A, Section 19(h) of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the County governing body, by a two-thirds majority vote, may petition to referendum the resolution approving an annexation within 45 days following final enactment of the annexation resolution. If the proposed resolution is approved by the Council, the City of Laurel will submit the resolution approving the annexation to a referendum of the voters of the areas proposed to be annexed.
