BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

Currently non-union County employees have no voice in the formation of County personnel policies and administrative decisions that directly affect them. This situation requires the County Council to serve as the only venue for receiving input from the employees' points of view when such policies are imposed by the County Executive. The proposed legislation would establish an Employee Advisory Council to provide collective representation to employees not represented by a labor organization to provide an employee – management conference board to facilitate the development of County policies concerning non-union County employees and foster positive employee relations.
