SECTION 1. BE IT	ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, sitting as the Di	istrict Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional	
District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-358 of the Zoning Ordinance of		
Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code,		
be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

1	Sec. 27-358. Gas station.
2	(a) A gas station may be permitted, subject to the following:
3	* * * * * * * *
4	(5) Access driveways shall be not less than thirty (30) feet wide <u>unless a lesser width</u>
5	is allowed for a one-way driveway by the Maryland State Highway Administration or the County
6	Department of Public Works and Transportation, whichever is applicable, and shall be
7	constructed in compliance with the minimum standards required by the County Road Ordinance
8	or Maryland State Highway Administration regulations, whichever is applicable. In the case of a
9	corner lot, a driveway may begin at a point not less than twenty (20) feet from the point of
10	curvature (PC) of the curb return or the point of curvature of the edge of paving at an intersection
11	without curb and gutter. A driveway may begin or end at a point not less than twelve (12) feet
12	from the side or rear lot line of any adjoining lot;
13	(6) Access driveways shall be defined by curbing;
14	(7) A sidewalk at least five (5) feet wide shall be provided in the area between the
15	building line and the curb in those areas serving pedestrian traffic.

17	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five
18	(45) calendar days after its adoption.
