AN ACT concerning

The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

For the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the civilian bargaining unit 2 (Supervisory) represented by the Deputy Sheriff's Association of Prince George's County, Inc.

WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has recommended to the County Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to the class of work described within Section 1 of this bill, in accordance with the Clarification of Unit/Amendment of Certification of Representation issued by the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board in Case Number 16 390 00013 96 for a position in the civilian bargaining unit 2 (Supervisory) represented by the Deputy Sheriff's Association of Prince George's County, Inc.; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

0144Z Administrative Aide IV, Z-19
(\$29,055 - \$44,955)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the job classification enumerated in Section 1 of this Bill shall be added retroactively to July 3, 1994.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
