	Spending Affordability Limits for the		
Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission			
For the purpose of establishing spending control limits on the Fiscal Year 2014 Water and Sewer			
Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC).			
WHEREAS, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and			
Prince George's County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend			
changes that would control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close			
to the level of infl	ation; and		
WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of			
a spending affordability process; and			
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's			
report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery County Council endorsed part			
of the report's recommendations through Resolution #12-1558; and			
WHEREAS, the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group			
Report spending a	affordability process; and		
WHEREAS, both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process			
beginning with the formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and			
WHEREAS, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the			
Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make			

certain recommendations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2014 Operating and Capital Budgets; and

1 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery Council have 2 reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the 3 percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council recommends that WSSC, in conjunction 4 5 with its Fiscal Year 2014 Budget transmittal, identify priority items that would not be funded 6 within the approved Fiscal Year 2014 spending control limits. These items can be considered for 7 funding at the May 2013 Bi-County meeting; and 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's 9 County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2014 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets 10 11 of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission: 12 13 Water and Sewer Bill increase: seven and one half percent (7.5%) 14 New Water and Sewer Debt: Five hundred and six million, four hundred 15 and seventeen thousand dollars 16 (\$506,417,000) 17 Water and Sewer Debt Service: Two hundred and twenty six million, six 18 hundred and twenty nine thousand dollars 19 (\$226,629,000) 20 Water and Sewer Operating Six hundred and fifty nine million, 21 Fund Expenditures: six hundred and fifty three thousand dollars 22 (\$659,653,000) 23
