**RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION concerning

The Listing of Local Questions on the 1992 Ballot  
FOR the purpose of designating the order and form in which  
local questions shall be placed on the 1992 ballot.

WHEREAS, Article 33, Section 16-6 of the Annotated Code of  
Maryland provides that the County Council shall certify the  
form in which local questions shall appear on the ballot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of  
Prince George's County, Maryland, that the order and form in  
which local questions shall appear on the ballot for the

November 1992 general election shall be as follows:

QUESTION A

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

To provide for the establishment of a contingency reserve fund of three percent of the County general fund in the proposed current expense budget submitted by the County Executive.

QUESTION B

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

To change the date that the proposed current expense budget of the County shall be submitted by the County Executive from March 31 to April 15, to change the dates that public hearings are held and to change the date the budget must be adopted by the Council from June 1 to June 15.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors of Elections by the Clerk of the Council.
