WHEREAS	S, Section 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance establishes procedures for the Prince
George's County	Planning Board to initiate a functional master plan, with the approval of the
District Council;	and
WHEREAS	s, the Approved FY 2003 Planning Department Work Program requires the
preparation of a l	Public Safety Master Plan, as a strategy to implement the policies of the 2002
General Plan; and	d
WHEREAS	s, in 1998 the County Council, with the assistance of Planning Department staff,
approved a polic	y paper, "Managing Growth in the 21st Century: A Smart Growth Initiative for
Prince George's	County," which recognized that the 1982 General Plan no longer guides growth
and land develop	ment adequately, from a County-wide perspective; and
WHEREAS	s, the County Council established Commission 2000, a 53-member task force, to
work with Planni	ing Department staff to prepare a Biennial Growth Policy Plan; and
WHEREAS	s, the Biennial Growth Policy Plan made recommendations concerning public
safety policies, to	support the County's goals for development and revitalization; and
WHEREAS	s, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, adopted
the first Biennial	Growth Policy Plan in CB-80-2000; and
WHEREAS	S, the 2002 General Plan for Prince George's County sets forth County-wide

1 goals, objectives, policies, and strategies to guide future development in the County, as to 2 location of public safety facilities; and 3 WHEREAS, ensuring public safety is essential to attracting quality development to the County, and the facilities needed to provide public safety services must therefore be reevaluated, 4 5 so that the they support the development pattern approved in the General Plan; and 6 WHEREAS, the Public Safety Master Plan is an implementation strategy in the General 7 Plan to serve the residents and workers in Prince George's County. 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's 9 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington 10 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Maryland-National Capital Park 11 and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Public Safety Master Plan for Prince 12 George's County, in accordance with Part 13 of the Zoning Ordinance. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of its 14 adoption.
