**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

An adequate public facilities test is currently conducted at the time of subdivision for transportation, police, and fire and rescue facilities. This legislation incorporates an APF test for schools into the subdivision regulations, Subtitle 24, and exempts certain types of development from this test.
