Committee Vote: (In favor (5-0): Council Members Lehman, Turner, Taveras, Franklin and Glaros)

Staff provided a summary of the bill and referral comments that were received. CB-72-2015, is an Act concerning the Transportation Network Company Services -Transportation Services Improvement Fund for the purpose of creating a Transportation Services Improvement Fund; imposing a per-trip surcharge on certain transportation network services to finance the Fund; providing for disbursements from the Fund to be used for transportation purposes; and generally regarding Transportation Network Services.

Staff provided a summary of the bill and referral comments that were received.

Martin Harris, Prince Georges County, Department of Public Works and Transportation, provided additional information and answered questions in Committee. Mr. Harris offered two amendments

- (1) On page 2, after line 7, insert: “(c) other transportation services;”
- (2) On page 3, after line 5, insert: “(3) other transportation purposes as prescribed by the Director.”

The Office of Law determined that CB-72-2015 was in proper legislative form and without legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits and Investigation indicated there will be a positive fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CB-72-2015. However, an accurate approximation of the fiscal impact on the County cannot be determined at this time.
