Dear Chairman Davis:

Enclosed for the County Council's consideration is a Resolution for the purpose of amending the Prince George's County Fiscal Year ("FY") 2016 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development by adding the Sunset Emergency Shelter Operations project, an eligible activity not originally funded or described in the FY 2016 Annual Action Plan. Additionally, this Resolution will amend the FY 2016 Annual Action Plan by reprogramming and reallocating seventy-two thousand one hundred seventy-nine dollars and ninety-two cents (\$72,179.92) in Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) Program funds from the FY 2001, FY 2007, FY 2008, FY 2009, FY 2010, and FY 2011 Annual Action Plans to support the Sunset Emergency Shelter Operations project.

The Sunset Emergency Shelter Operations project involves basic shelter amenities as well as employment, case management, health care, and housing placement for approximately one thousand (1,000) homeless individuals and families, located within Prince George's County, Maryland.

This Resolution requires at least one public hearing because each of the proposed amendments to the FY 2016 Annual Action Plan would constitute a "substantial change" under the FY 2016-2020 County Citizen Participation Plan.
