For the purpose of identifying inconsistencies between the Preliminary Glenn Dale-Seabrook-		
Lanham and Vicinity Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment and existing or		
proposed State or County facilities, and approving the inclusion of any new transportation		
proposals prior to the adoption of the Sector Plan by the Planning Board.		
WHEREAS,	, the District Council adopted CR-53-2008 on May 27, 2008, initiating an	
amendment to the 1993 Approved Master Plan for Glenn Dale-Seabrook-Lanham and Vicinity in		
order to develop a	a comprehensive approach to implement the recommendations of the 2002	
General Plan, and to ensure that future development is consistent with County policies; and		
WHEREAS	, the Sector Plan area, being part of Planning Area 70, is approximately 10.9	
square miles in ce	entral Prince George's County. The area is bounded by Good Luck Road,	
Cipriano Road, ar	nd Greenbelt Road (MD 193) to the north; Glenn Dale Boulevard (MD 193),	
Daisy Lane, Hilln	neade Road, Annapolis Road (MD 450), Enterprise Road (MD193) to the east;	
John Hanson High	hway (US 50) to the south, Capital Beltway (I-95/I-495) to the west; and also	
includes the Princ	ee George's Sports Center Property off adjacent to Good Luck Road; and	
WHEREAS.	Section 27-645(b)(1) of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County,	
Maryland, require	es the Prince George's County Planning Board of The Maryland-National	
Capital Park and Planning Commission to submit its proposals for public facilities in the plan to		

the District Council and to the County Executive prior to adoption by the Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance also provides a review period for the County Executive and the District Council to review, provide written comments, and identify any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities including roads, highways, or other public facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-645(b)(1) further provides that the adopted plan may not include a highway or transportation line unless the District Council, after consultation with the County Executive, approves (by resolution) the inclusion of the highway or transportation line for planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board referred the public facilities element of the Preliminary Glenn Dale-Seabrook-Lanham & Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment for review, comments, and the identification of any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities on July 23, 2009, attached hereto as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, upon review the District Council has concluded that, in general, the public facilities transportation proposals contained in the preliminary Sector Plan are consistent with the County's Capital Improvement Program ("CIP") and the State's Consolidated Transportation Program ("CTP").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the transportation system and public facilities proposals in the public facilities element of the Preliminary Glenn Dale-Seabrook-Lanham & Vicinity Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment, as transmitted on July 23, 2009, by the Prince George's Planning Board of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, are hereby approved for inclusion in the preliminary plan.
