RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning
2 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission – Prince George’s County Members
3 – Appointment and Geographic Balance

4 For the purpose of addressing the geographic distribution and balance of the membership of the
5 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and confirming Gloria Gary Lawlah
6 to serve as a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission of the
7 Prince George’s County Planning Board to serve on a part-time basis.

8 WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Land Use Article, Section 15-103(b)(4)
9 requires that, in making and approving appointments to the Maryland-National Capital Park and
10 Planning Commission, the County Council and County Executive shall attempt to provide
11 reasonable geographic balance with respect to the places of residence of the members; and

12 WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Land Use Article, Section 15-103(b)(4)
13 further requires that the appointment resolution for each appointment shall describe the resulting
14 geographic distribution and provide appropriate explanations; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly nominated Gloria Gary Lawlah, a resident of
16 Temple Hills, to serve as a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning
17 Commission and to serve part-time on the Prince George’s County Planning Board; and

18 WHEREAS, a public hearing on the nomination and confirmation of Gloria Gary Lawlah
19 has been held; and

20 WHEREAS, the remaining members of the Commission from Prince George’s County
21 reside in Oxon Hill, Brentwood, and Bowie.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

1 County, Maryland, that with the appointment of Gloria Gary Lawlah to the Maryland-National
2 Capital Park and Planning Commission, there continues to be a reasonable geographic
3 distribution with respect to places of residence of the members of the Commission from Prince
4 George’s County.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Gloria Gary Lawlah is hereby confirmed as a member
6 of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission of the Prince George’s County
7 Planning Board, with a term expiring June 15, 2027.
