Staff provided a summary of the resolution and referral comments that were received. CR-100-2013 approves the application by the Redevelopment Authority of Prince Georges County, in the amount of \$393,940, to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for funding through the Strategic Demolition and Smart Growth Impact Fund. This project will provide infrastructure revitalization for the Maryland Park Drive & Southern Avenue Pedestrian and Roadway Improvements project in Capitol Heights, Maryland, which is a State-Designated Sustainable Community within the Priority Funding area.
