## A RESOLUTION concerning

## Personnel Board Subpoena

For the purpose of issuing a subpoena pursuant to Section 1012 of the Charter for Prince George's County in response to a request initiated by the Personnel Board pursuant to Section 16-105 of the County Code.

WHEREAS, Section 1012 of the County Charter provides that the County Council shall have the power to require the production of records and other materials in connection with any hearing authorized by law or by the Charter; and

WHEREAS, Section 907 of the County Charter provides that the Personnel Board is responsible to hear and decide appeals of various actions of the Personal Officer and appointing authorities; and

WHEREAS, Section 16-105 of the County Code, the Personnel Board May, upon a majority vote of the full Board, make application to the County Council for the issuance of subpoenas upon any person to require such person to attend, testify, and produce documents and records regarding the subject of any appeal before the Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Personnel Board made application by letter dated May 29, 2009 to the County Council for the issuance of subpoenas for persons to attend, testify and produce documents and records regarding the subject of an appeal by Vanessa J. Springer as requested by her attorney in a request dated April 29, 2009 from Joseph, Greenwald & Laake, P. A. (Puja Gupta) to the Personal Board; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has reviewed the application of the Personnel Board. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

- 2. List of all Police Department employees present at Summerfield housing complex on December 4, 2008.
- 3. All incident reports, Commander's Information Reports, use of force reports, medical reports, or any other reports generated as a result of the alleged assault that occurred on December 4, 2008.
- 4. All Training Commission objectives and training manuals, including, but not limited to instructions for conducting Basic Survival Training (BST) and/or policies and practices for student officers and instructors of the Prince Georges County Community Policing Institute.
- 5. Statements made to Internal Affairs by LT Disque, SGTs Salen, Ashton and McClenan, CPLs Qualls, Burd, Fowble, Miller and Larson.
- 6. Mobile phone records for any Police Department phones used by LT Disque, SGTs Salen, Ashton and McClenan, CPLs Qualls, Burd, Fowble, Miller and Larson for the dates from May 27, 2008 through December 26, 2008, inclusive.
- 7. All videotapes or video recordings stored in any form depicting any Basic Survival Training scenario in which Appellant was involved.
- 8. Any and all emails discussing or relating to incidents involving the Appellant, including but not limited to her performance, complaint or termination.
- 9. Any self-check-in lists, attendance sheets or rosters of any type assigning or listing County police officers for role playing parts for Basic Survival Training for Session 114 on December 4, 2008.
- 10. The full name and identification number of an unidentified male role player present for Basic Survival Training for Session 114 on December 4, 2008.
