BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Farmer's Markets

3 For the purpose of transferring and making amendments to the temporary permit requirements
4 for farmer's markets in Prince George's County.

5 BY adding:

6 **SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.**
7 Section 5-208,
8 The Prince George's County Code
9 (2015 Edition).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 5-208 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 added:

13 **SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.**
14 **DIVISION 16. FARMER'S MARKETS.**

15 **Sec. 5-208. Farmer's Markets.**

16 The Department of Permits, Inspections, and Enforcement may issue a temporary permit for
17 a farmer's market temporary use, as that use is defined in Section 27-107.01(a)(87.1) of this
18 Code, subject to the following requirements:

19 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Section, the farmer's market shall only be located
20 on the open area or parking lot of private or publicly owned property.

1 (b) The farmer's market use shall be operated only within the hours as specified in the
2 application and approved by the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement.

3 (c) Vehicular access to the subject property shall not be by means of streets internal to
4 subdivisions for one-family dwellings.

5 (d) The Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement may revoke the permit if
6 the use constitutes a nuisance because of noise, traffic, physical activity, or other cause.

7 (e) The permit for a farmer's market shall be issued for no more than 106 days in any one
8 (1) calendar year.

9 (f) A farmer's market may operate inside a public or privately owned building with the
10 written permission of the property owner during the months of December through March for a
11 period not to exceed a total of thirty (30) days, provided the farmer's market otherwise complies
12 with the provisions of this Section and Section 27-107.01(a)(87.1) of this Code.

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on January 1,
2 2017.
