1 AN ACT concerning

2 Solid Waste Advisory Commission Composition

3 For the purpose of amending the Solid Waste Advisory Commission by revising the number of
4 appointed members serving on the Commission; reestablishing the process for appointments to
5 the Commission; and generally related to the appointments of the Solid Waste Advisory
6 Commission.

7 BY repealing and reenacting:

8 SUBTITLE 21. REFUSE.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
13 Maryland, that Section 21-125.03 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same are
14 hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

16 **DIVISION 1. REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL.**

17 **SUBDIVISION 2. SOLID WASTE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING ADVISORY**

20 **Sec.21.125.03. Commission composition; term; officers.**

21 (a) The Commission shall be composed of [nine (9)] no less than nine (9) and no more than

1 | fifteen (15) members appointed by the County Executive and subject to the confirmation by the
2 | County Council. At least five (5) of the appointments, one of whom shall be designated as the
3 | vice chairman, shall be selected from a list of persons submitted by the County Council. One (1)
4 | ex-officio member may be appointed by the County Executive and one (1) ex-officio member
5 | may be appointed by the County Council. Members shall be selected so as to represent broad
6 | geographic areas of the County, the solid waste industry, business users, environmental, public
7 | health and civic community and the general public, at least one member shall be appointed from
8 | the communities surrounding the Brown Station Road landfill.

9 | (b) The term of office for each member shall be three (3) years.

10 | (c) The County Executive shall designate two (2) members to serve as chairman and vice
11 | chairman. The Commission members shall elect annually from their own membership such other
12 | officers as it deems necessary. Staff support shall be provided by the Department of the
13 | Environment.

15 | SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
16 | calendar days after it becomes law.
