**REPORT:** Committee Vote: **Favorable**, 3-0 (In favor: Council Members Patterson, Taveras, and Turner)

CR-6-2015 is a Resolution concerning the rules and regulations governing the implementation and administration of the Fair Criminal Record Screening Standards.

As proposed the Resolution approves the rules and regulations promulgated by the Executive Director of the Human Relations Commission which shall govern the implementation and administration of the Fair Criminal Screening Standards codified in Section 2, Division 12, and Subdivision 10 of the County Code. The rules and regulations are attached to the proposed Resolution as Attachment A.

The Human Relations Commission expressed concerns about the funding of a person needed to carry out the provisions of the original act. It was stated that the Committee would review this in context with the review of the FY 2016 Budget.

The Office of Law finds the Resolution to be in proper form.

The Office of Audits and Investigations finds that the Resolution will have no adverse fiscal impact on the County.
