BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

This bill is to adopt and approve the referenced collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Section 16-233(e) of the Personnel Law. The County and Council 67, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Locals 2462 and 2735 reopened their existing three-year labor agreement through fiscal year 1992 for AFSCME employees and negotiated a new collective bargaining agreement covering fiscal years 1992 and 1993. The detail of the cost savings resulting from this agreement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
