Staff oriented the Committee along with all legislative comments. CR-134-2013 concerns the Prince George's County Construction and Demolition Waste Diversion Work Group. This work eleven (11) member work group will review and evaluate the creation and implementation of diversion of construction and demolition waste program for reuse, recycling and salvaging and to recommend appropriate policies and or legislation for such a County program and report back to the Council by May 31, 2014.
