Mary Godfrey, Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, briefed the Committee on the U.S. Air Arena project originally approved for \$250,000 to conduct a feasibility study for the Arena. \$60,733 of these funds were utilized for a study conducted by the Maryland Stadium Authority. No further funding is required for this project. The Council requested that they be provided a copy of the study.

The Commission requested that the remaining funding, \$189,267, be approved for consultant fees for large scale park projects. Committee Members expressed a concern that these funds not be used for legal fees. The Commission and the County Executive's representative assured the Council that this project would be closely monitored.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

By letter dated 3/13/96, the Prince George's County Planning Board requested that the FY 96 M-NCPPC Capital Budget be amended to transfer funding in the amount of \$189,267 from the U.S. Air Arena project to a project titled General Park Needs Study.

The U.S. Air Arena project was first approved in the FY 1995 Capital Budget in the amount of \$250,000 in bond funds. This project was to conduct a feasibility study for possible uses of the U.S. Air Arena. A project fund balance of \$189,267 has been identified. The Commission is seeking to utilize these funds to conduct park needs and/or feasibility studies, as required, throughout the County.

Section 2-118(a)(6) of Article 28 of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for amendments by resolution of the County Council after receipt of the County Executive's recommendation and after a public hearing.
