2	Maryland State Contributory Pension System	
3	For the purpose of electing to provide employees of the County with the contributory pension	
4	benefit under Title 23 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.	
5	WHEREAS, Section 16-230 of the Prince George's County Code provides for the	
6	participation of County employees, officers, and elected and appointed officials in the State	
7	Retirement System and the State Pension System in accordance with Division II, State Personne	el
8	and Pensions Article, Annotated Code of Maryland; and	
9	WHEREAS, the County Council previously adopted CR-74-1979 to provide for the	
10	participation of County employees and employees of the Board of Education who were not	
11	eligible to participate in the Teachers' Pension System with benefits under the State Pension	
12	System, effective January 1, 1980; and	
13	WHEREAS, Chapter 176 of the Laws of Maryland 1999 granted each participating	
14	governmental unit the right to irrevocably elect, no later than December 31, 1999, to provide its	5
15	employees with the contributory pension benefit under Title 23 of the State Personnel and	
16	Pensions Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended by Chapter 176; and	
17	WHEREAS, the County Council adopted CR-27-1999 to establish a Pension System Task	ſ
18	Force to review the County's opportunity to participate in the revised Employees' Pension	
19	System and to recommend to the County Executive and the County Council whether to elect to	
20	participate in the contributory Employees' Pension System; and	
21	WHEREAS, the Pension System Task Force has evaluated the current and anticipated cos	
22	to the County and to participating employees to provide the contributory pension benefits of the	e

Employees' Pension System, the value of such enhanced benefits to eligible employees, and the
 costs to provide comparable benefits in other combinations of benefit programs and
 recommended that the provision of contributory pension benefits through the Employees'
 Pension System as the most comprehensive and most cost effective alternative available to the
 County to provide adequate pension benefits to that portion of the County work force who are
 required by State law to participate in the Employees' Pension System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that pursuant to Section 31-116 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland (the "Pension Article") on the date of adoption of this Resolution it irrevocably elects to provide its employees with the contributory pension benefit under Title 23 of the Pension Article.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County, Maryland agrees to
continue to abide by all laws, rules, and regulations governing the Employees' Pension System
and the Employees' Retirement System, as now in force and as amended from time to time.
