REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorable 4-0 (Council Members Watson, Harrison, Hawkins, and Oriadha), Absent (Dernoga)

The Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on June 27, 2024, to consider CB-57-2024, an act concerning the classification plan for Prince George's County. The legislation would amend the Classification Plan pursuant to the County Code. This Bill proposes to reallocate the grade associated with the Executive Director class of work.

Council staff provided an overview of the legislation, which will reallocate grades for the Executive Director class of work from G-33 to G-36. The administration feels this is necessary to enable certain agencies to hire Deputy Directors who are grade G-35 to meet their increasing operational needs. Enactment of CB-057-2024 may have a direct adverse fiscal impact on the County, as the Executive Director class of work may increase compensation costs.

Sakinda Skinner, representing the Office of the County Executive, asked for a favorable recommendation and introduced the new Deputy Director of the Office of Human Resources Management, Valarie Farrar.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee reported CB-57-2024 out of committee favorably, 4-0.
