BILL

AN ACT concerning

The Classification Plan for Prince George's County
FOR the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the
bargaining unit represented by Prince George's Correctional
Officers' Association, Inc. (PGCOA).

WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the
Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16
of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order to provide better
governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments
to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect
to certain classes of work described within Section 1 of this bill;
and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the
Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16
of the Prince George's County Code, has recommended to the County
Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's
County with respect to the classes of work described within Section

1 of this bill, in accordance with the certification of Representation issued by the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board in AAA Case Number 16 39 00121 89W for positions in the bargaining unit represented by PGCOA; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

2756F Food Service Specialist I,
F-15 (\$21,549 - \$31,754)

2757F Food Service Specialist II,
F-16 (\$22,626 - \$33,342)

2758F Food Service Coordinator I,
F-18 (\$24,946 - \$36,759)

2759F Food Service Coordinator II,
F-20 (\$27,503 - \$40,527)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and that the provision of Section 1 of this Act shall be retroactively effective to January 1, 1991.
