Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Peters, Campos, Dean and Knotts).

This bill will provide \$1.75 million in supplementary appropriations for two capital projects as follows:

- 1. \$750,000 to increase the County Revitalization and Restoration Project (CRR) which will be used to begin planning the new Edmonston Pumping Station.
- 2. \$1,000,000 which will increase the African-American Museum and will be used to plan the new museum.

Revenue to fund these two capital projects is part of the extensive General Fund transfer list in CB-24-2006 which appropriates prior year uncommitted fund balance for these two projects.

There will be no negative fiscal impact as a result of enacting CB-26-2006.
