This resolution will amend the County Electrical Code. These changes will simplify the current fee schedule and ensure that the permit fees are consistent with those of other jurisdictions in the metropolitan area.

The Director of Department of Environmental Resources said the new fee schedule will reduce the time necessary for permit processing, make the fees more easily understood by the permitees and allow reviewers to focus more time on the plan review instead of the calculation of fees.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-49-1998.
