The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on Wednesday, October 15, 2020, to consider CB-086-2020, An Act Concerning Special Food Service Facilities – Food Halls. CB-086-2020 creates a definition for Food Halls, creates a process for application, establishes a business license and an approval process. The bill would also set forth insurance requirements for license holders and delineates safety, sanitation and inspection requirements.

General support was expressed by the Council.

The Office of Law found CB-086-2020 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Policy Analysis Group reports that CB-086-2020 should have minimal fiscal impact on the County relating to inspection and enforcement.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CB-086-2020 out favorably, 11-0.
