MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH MNCPPC

Key Timelines & Responsibilities

- PHASE 1: Shall apply to all PGCPS Artificial Turf
 Athletic Fields and any future new schools (July 2023)
- PHASE 2: Shall consist of additional PGCPS Facilities and Fields in the north, central and south County, as negotiated by PGCPS and M-NCPPC. (July 2024)
- PHASE 3: Shall consist of all PGCPS Facilities and Fields for all PGCPS schools as negotiated by PGCPS and M-NCPPC. (July 2025)

- MNCPPC Facilitate and Schedule 3rd party request.





TYPICAL COST

Full stadium upgrades are **as much as \$7.5M**, depending on the individual site needs that vary on the requisite earthwork, stormwater management devices, drainage, and existing site constraints but also the need to include:

Electronic LED Interactive Scoreboards	Bleachers	Track & Field Events
Stadium & Egress Lighting	Press Boxes	Storage Facilities

CLIMATE CHANGE CONSIDERATIONS

With the adoption of the Climate Action Change Plan by the Prince George's County Board of Education, PGCPS joins the current national discourse around how to achieve the benefits of artificial turf (e.g., no restrictive recovery/rest period, relative ease of maintenance) with a more natural grass product that is still suitable for such high-use, cooperatively-shared fields.
