RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Refuse Collection

FOR the purpose of providing that the Department of Environmental Resources permit County residents to dispose of refuse at County-owned land fills without charge twice each year.

WHEREAS, the County has established programs and facilities for the disposal of household refuse by County residents at County-owned land fills; and

WHEREAS, certain types of refuse are not currently permitted to be disposed of at the County-owned land fills at all times; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council that County residents have the opportunity to dispose of household refuse of all types at least twice each year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Director of the Department of

Environmental Resources is directed to develop a program that permits each County resident to deliver to County-owned land fills for disposal refuse of all types at least twice each year and report back to the Council with an implementation schedule for this program within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the date of adoption of this resolution.
