The Prince George's County Council, sitting as the committee of the whole, convened on June 11, 2025, to consider CB-060-2025, an act concerning County Real Property and declaring certain parcels of County-owned real property as surplus and no longer needed for County use.

This legislation will declare parcels of property contained in the County's Inventory of Real Property and improvements as surplus and facilitate the County Executive's plan for the disposition of such parcels. The legislation provides for the designation of twelve (12) real property tax parcels as surplus.

The Redevelopment Authority will administer the disposition plan for economic development purposes.

The Office of Law found the legislation to be legally sufficient with no legal impediments to enactment.

Ms. Sakinda Skinner requested support on behalf of the Office of the County Executive.

After further discussion, the Prince George's County Council sitting as The Committee of the Whole voted favorably, 9-0.
