## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

## **Contract Approvals**

For the purpose of approving a multi-year contract to procure maintenance services for the County's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management's communication equipment and supporting software.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland the County Council must approve, by resolution, all multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince Georges County, Maryland no agency of the County Government shall, during any fiscal year, expend any money or incur any liability in excess of the amounts appropriated and no such payment shall be made, nor any obligation or liability incurred, except for purchase in an amount to be fixed by legislative act; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Motorola Solution, Inc (Contractor) for the purposes of ensuring continuing maintenance of legacy software, hardware, licenses for radio communications, computer aided software, mobile data, 911 Center phone equipment (Plant Vesta) records management software and Next Generation 9-1-1; and

WHEREAS, the contract between Prince George's County, Maryland and Contractor, will be conducted pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein as Attachment A.

WHEREAS, County Code Section 10A-114(a)(1)(F) provides that the Purchasing Agent is authorized to award a contract by non-competitive negotiation when only one product will meet the technical performance requirements for the procurement nature; and

WHEREAS, the County Purchasing Agent has determined that the Contractor is the only practical source for continuing the provision of such support and maintenance services and it is in the County's best interest to continue to utilize the Contractor for the support and maintenance of ASTRO 25 Radio Communication System, 911 Center, and related technology including CAD, Mobile Data, and Plant Vesta (911 Phone Equipment).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the agreement as described in Attachment A and pursuant to Section 819 of the Prince George's County Charter be and the same is hereby APPROVED.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make any modifications, adjustment, correction, or any other changes as may be necessary to finalize the contract in any manner the County Executive may deem necessary or proper but not altering its substance.
