ZONING BILL

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning
2 Corrective Bill – Adult Book Stores and/or Adult Video Stores
3 For the purpose of amending the zoning ordinance to extend the time period that adult book
4 stores and/or adult video stores may continue in operation; making a certain correction as set
5 forth in CB-28-2009; and generally relating to making an amendment to correct an omission in
6 CB-28-2009.

7 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

8 Section 27-248,
9 The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,
10 being also
11 SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.
12 The Prince George's County Code
13 (2007 Edition, 2008 Supplement, as amended by CB-28-2009).

14 SECTION 1. WHEREAS, CB-28-2009 generally relating to adult book stores and/or adult
15 video stores was amended to provide, among other things, that all certified nonconforming adult
16 book stores and/or adult video stores may continue in operation until January 1, 2011;

17 WHEREAS, the corresponding amendment to Section 27-248 was omitted in CB-28-2009;

18 WHEREAS, the purpose of this legislation is to correct the omission in CB-28-2009 by
19 amending Section 27-248; now, therefore

1 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five
2 (45) calendar days after its adoption.
