## POLICIES IN AREA MASTER PLANS OR SECTOR PLANS ADOPTED PRIOR TO THE 1 2 GENERAL PLAN. 3 [(6)] (7) The development proposed in a detailed site plan for infrastructure complies 4 with applicable regulations of PART 27-6: Development Standards, prevents offsite property 5 damage, and prevents environmental degradation to safeguard the public's health, safety, welfare, and economic well-being for grading, reforestation, woodland conservation, drainage, erosion, 6 7 and pollution discharge; 8 [(7)] (8) Places of worship located on a lot between one (1) and two (2) acres in size 9 shall also meet the following standards: 10 (A) The minimum setback for all buildings shall be twenty-five (25) feet from each lot line: 11 12 (B) When possible, there should be no parking or loading spaces located in the 13 front yard; and 14 (C) The maximum allowable lot coverage for the zone in which the use is 15 proposed shall not be increased. 16 [(8)] (9) Notwithstanding any other provision in this Section to the contrary, in 17 determining whether to approve an alteration, extension, or enlargement of a legal conforming 18 building, structure, or use filed in conformance with Section 27-1707(c), the Planning Board 19 shall find that the proposed alteration, extension, or enlargement will benefit the development 20 and will not substantially impair implementation of any applicable area master plan or sector 21 plan. 22 SECTION 2.
