Resolution No. CR-68-2009 Council Member Turner Proposed by Introduced by Council Members Turner, Bland, Dean, Harrison, Dernoga, Olson and Campos Date of Introduction September 29, 2009 RESOLUTION A RESOLUTION concerning National Teen Driver Safety Week For the purpose of observing the National Teen Safety Driver Week established to raise awareness about the tragedy of teen vehicle crashes, the leading cause of death for young people in the United States. WHEREAS, the leading cause of death for young people in the United States is vehicle crashes above drug overdose and suicide; and WHEREAS, national statistics state that 16 year-olds have higher crash rates than drivers of any other age; and 16-year-olds are three times more likely to die in a motor vehicle crash than the average of all drivers; and WHEREAS, drivers age 15-20 accounted for 12.9 percent of all the drivers involved in fatal crashes and 16 percent of all the drivers involved in police-reported crashes in 2006; and WHEREAS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) estimates the economic impact of auto accidents involving 15-20 year old drivers is over \$40 billion and a recent report by AAA estimates the cost of crashes involving 15-17 year olds to be \$34 billion; and WHEREAS, statistics show that 16 and 17-year-old driver death rates increase with
