## LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Fiscal and Planning Committee Report Date: June 25, 1990

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Bell,

Casula, MacKinnon, Pemberton and Wilson).

This legislation adopts and incorporates the terms of the existing Multi-Unit collective bargaining agreement covering other AFSCME represented employees in Local 2462, 2735 and 1691 and tailors it to this particular unit. Specific modifications address the meal period and allowance provision, the tool allowance provision, the promotions provision and the grievance procedure. All other terms and provisions common to Locals 2462, 2735 and 1691, particularly the cost of living adjustments (4% in 1990 and 91 and 7% in FY92) will apply to the members of the Bureau of Apparatus Maintenance Unit.

The Legislative Officer and Office of Law have reviewed the legislation

and find it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The fiscal impact on the County will be negative in the amount of \$51,616 during the three year term of the agreement.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

This bill makes amendments to the Classification Plan to assign the Breathing Apparatus Technician I, II and III classifications to grades on Salary Schedule A in accordance with Public Employee Relations Board AAA Case No. 16 39 00256 88S. This bill is a companion measure to legislation to enact a new collective bargaining agreement with AFSCME covering members in the Fire Department Bureau of Apparatus Maintenance Unit back to July 1, 1989.
