PZED Committee Report

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Dean, Bland, Dernoga, Knotts, and Olson)

Staff gave an overview of the purpose of the resolution. CR-25-2010 provides for a transfer of appropriations and expenditures between certain programs in the FY 2009-10 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund. The proposed adjustments include a decrease in the amount of \$20,000 from the Dream Makers Basketball Academy and an increase in the same amount to the Prince George's Arts Council.

The proposed transfer of funds is internal to the Commission's already approved FY 2009 Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund and there is no fiscal impact on the County as a result of the proposed resolution.

The Office of Law reviewed CR-25-2010 and determined that it is in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This resolution provides for the transfer of \$20,000 in Recreation funds from the Dream Makers Basketball Academy program to the Prince George's Arts Council. This results in no change to the total expenditures approved in the Recreation Fund.
