



HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL REVIEW: SUMMARY

- There are significant differences in the size and various socio-demographic characteristics of each jurisdiction.
- Out of the five jurisdictions, Prince George's County FY 2018 Approved Health and Human Services Total Budget ranks second.
- Out of the five jurisdictions, Prince George's County FY 2018 Approved Health and Human Services General Fund Budget ranks fourth (or 2nd lowest).
- Prince George's County Health and Human Services agencies have the highest proportion of Grant Funded among the selected comparison group (67.55% in Approved FY 2018 Budget).
- Prince George's County has <u>the lowest FY</u> 2018 All Funds approved Health and Human Services spending per person among the comparison group (\$121.33).
- Prince George's County has <u>the lowest FY</u> 2018 General Fund approved Health and Human Services spending per person among the comparison group (\$38.94).

UNANSWERED QUESTIONS

This overview provides basic information, and there are many remaining unanswered questions, including:

- What are the population needs for various health and human services in Prince George's County?
- What is the range of services currently provided? To what extent does the current level of services meet the population needs?
- To what extent are current levels of services restrictive/reactive versus inclusive/proactive?
- How are population needs being met? Through the government agencies, non-profit organizations, other service providers?
- What is the capacity of the government sector and the non-profit sector to meet the population needs? How does this capacity compare to capacities of other jurisdictions to meet their populations' needs?
- How effective is our service delivery? Is there a duplication of effort among agencies?
- How accessible are the services?
- What is the quality of services provided? What are the outcomes?
