POSITION STATEMENT

(HB 317) Labor and Employment - Wages and Benefits -

Delegate Dereck Davis Preemption of Local Authority

POSITION: OPPOSE

HB 317 prohibits counties and municipalities from regulating the wages or benefits that an employer other than the county or municipality may provide to its employees. This bill would preempt any county or municipality from enacting or enforcing a law to regulate the wages or benefits provided by an employer other the county or municipality, if the provision was enacted on or after January 1, 2017.

In this great State of Maryland, we operate with the understanding that each county is as unique as each of its inhabitants. That is why well-intentioned Statewide mandates that impact county and municipal budgets sometimes have the effect of creating an undue burden or increased deficits. Given that fact, we believe it is appropriate that a provision as impactful as wages or benefits should match the uniqueness of each county.

Our residents should have the ability to make a livable wage that is best determined by the statistics of our county and regulated by its governing body. While we respect the authority that the statute bestows on the Commissioner of Labor and Industry, this Council is accountable to the residents of Prince George's County and thereby responsible for each resident's well-being.

While this body is understanding of the spirit in which this bill is proffered, particularly as it relates to ensuring economic equality, we feel strongly that these type of measures contemplated in this legislation should remain local prerogative. Therefore, the County Council strongly urges an UNFAVORABLE report on House Bill 317 and respectfully requests your favorable consideration of our position.
