11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, that Section 4-356 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby
13 added:

14 **SUBTITLE 4. BUILDING.**

15 **DIVISION 5. ADMINISTRATION**

16 **Sec. 4-356. The Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement; reporting.**

17 (a) The Director or a designee of the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement
18 shall provide a monthly written report to each of the Prince George's County Council
19 Members.

20 (b) The report shall contain the following data for each councilmanic district:

21 (1) The twenty (20) most frequent complaints received by the Department;

- 1 (2) The twenty (20) most frequent citations distributed by the Department;
- 2 (3) The twenty (20) most frequent citations that are responded to and paid off; and
- 3 (4) The twenty (20) most frequent citations that are referred for legal action.

4 (c) The Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement shall provide a quarterly
5 report of pursuant to Subsection (b) to be posted on the Department webpage.

6 (d) The Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement shall present a quarterly
7 report to the County Council pursuant to Subsection (b).

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Department shall report back to the County Council no more than ninety (90) days after enactment of this Act with the Department's strategy of implementation.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
