**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

The State of Maryland requires a resolution by the County Council for each Community Legacy Program application for unincorporated areas. If this application is approved by the State, the International Corridor community will receive funding in the amount of \$2,500,000 for renovation of the historic McCormick Mansion in order to establish a multicultural service center in the building.
