Procurement Regulations Regarding Minority Business Enterprises For the purpose of approving amendments to the Prince George's County Procurement Regulations to add Native Americans to the definition of minority individuals and refine the definitions of certain groups identified in the definition of minority individuals.

WHEREAS, Section 10A-105 of the Prince George's County Code provides that the Purchasing Agent shall recommend regulations concerning sole source procurements, emergency procurements, special circumstance procurements, and the Minority Business Opportunities Program, to the County Council for approval by resolution; and

WHEREAS, CR-3-1992 adopted the Procurement Regulations of the County; and WHEREAS, by CB-43-2011, Section 10A-101 of the County Code was amended to add Native Americans to the definition of minority individuals; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend the Procurement Regulations to implement the amendments of Section 10A-101 of the County Code to add Native Americans to the definition of minority individuals and refine the definitions of certain groups identified in the definition of minority individuals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Purchasing Agent is directed to take all steps necessary and appropriate to amend the Prince George's County Procurement Regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Chapter III of the Prince George's County Procurement Regulations has been amended as described in Attachment "A" and incorporated herein by reference.
