## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

## County Labor Code

For the purpose of establishing a work group to review the County Labor Code and recommend appropriate amendments to the County Council and County Executive.

WHEREAS, Section 908 of the County Charter provides that the County Council shall provide by law a labor code for County employees; and

WHEREAS, Subtitle 13A of the County Code was first enacted into law in 1973; and WHEREAS, a comprehensive review of Subtitle 13A is needed to evaluate the County Labor Code in light of contemporary developments in public sector labor relations; and

WHEREAS, the County has adopted a Total Quality Management initiative that incorporates the concepts of continuous improvement, management by fact, and employee involvement in quality improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that a work group be established to review the County Labor Code and recommend appropriate amendments to the Labor Code and labor relations practices to the County Council and County Executive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following persons or their designated representative shall comprise the work group: a representative of the County Executive, a representative of the County Council Chairman, the Personnel Officer, the County Attorney, the Executive Director of Council 67, American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, the President of Fraternal Order of Police, Prince George's County Lodge 89, Inc.,

the President of Prince George's County Professional Firefighters Association, Local 1619, two members of the private sector appointed by the Council Chairman, and support staff provided by the Council Administrator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work group shall provide its written recommendations for appropriate amendments to the Labor Code to the County Council and County Executive on or before December 31, 1995.
