## TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE DATE: 5/1/00

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Shapiro, Gourdine, Hendershot, Maloney and Wilson).

Staff gave an overview of the legislation and informed the Committee of referral comments that were received. The Director of the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) explained that CR-10-2000 is the County's submittal to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) of a five year strategic plan for housing, homelessness, special needs populations, community and economic development and revitalization. The County is mandated to submit this five year plan since the County is the recipient of funds under four federal entitlement programs. The four federal entitlement programs are: Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnership, Emergency Shelter Grant and Housing Opportunities for Person with AIDS.

The Office of Law finds CR-10-2000 to be in proper legislative form.
